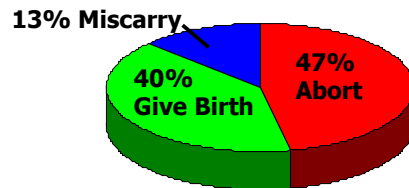


# Abortions in America

- In the United States of all pregnancies 52% are intended while 48% are unintended.
- Approximately 3 million pregnancies each year are unintended.

## Outcomes of Unintended Pregnancies



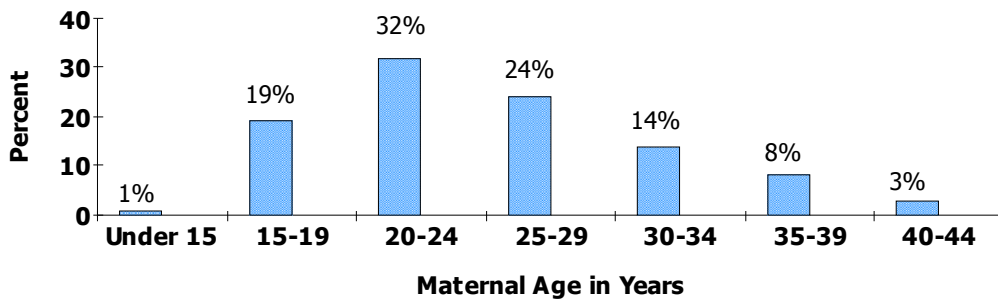
- There are approximately 1.3 million abortions in the U.S. each year.
- There has been a steady decline in abortions since 1980.
- Abortion is now the most common surgical procedure in the U.S.
- By age 20, 1 in 7 women have had at least one abortion.
- By age 45, 4 in 10 have had at least one abortion.
- The U.S. has the highest abortion rate (22.9 per 1,000) of any western industrialized nation.
- 88.1% of all abortions take place by the twelfth week of pregnancy.
- Only 1% of all abortions take place because of rape and/or incest.
- Women give an average of 3.7 reasons why they are seeking an abortion including the following:

21%	Inadequate finances	8%	Children are grown; she has all she wants
21%	Not ready for responsibility	3%	Baby has possible health problems
16%	Woman's life would be changed too much	3%	woman has health problems
12%	Problems with Relationships; Unmarried	1%	Pregnancy caused by rape/incest
11%	Too young and/or immature	4%	Other
- 49% of women who abort will abort again.

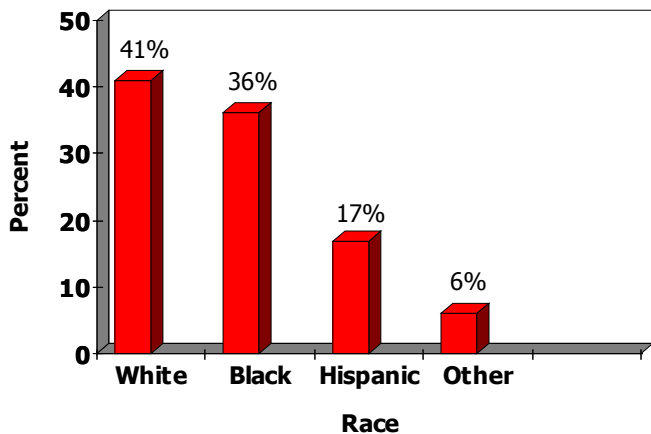

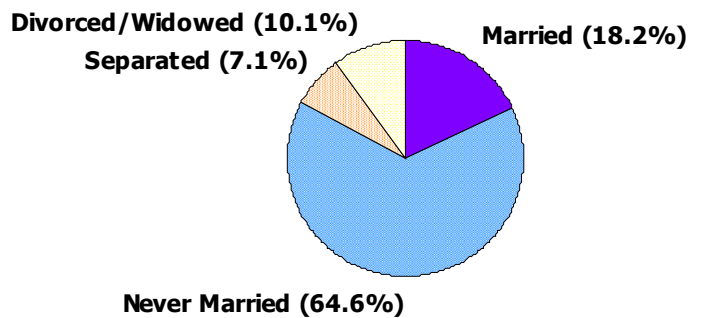
## Abortions by Maternal Age



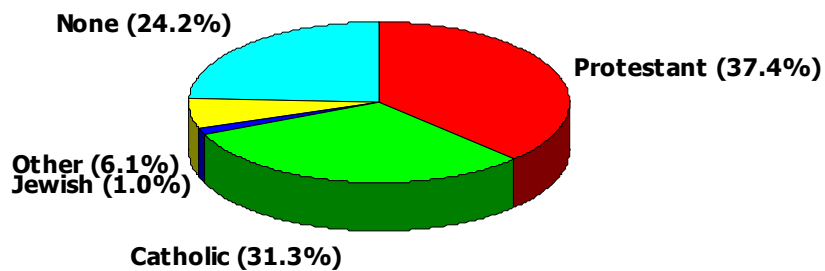
## Abortions by Race
