Vision for Victory

St Louis, MO – “Operation Rescue West came to our city and shut down the abortion mill,” said Angela Michael of Small Victories, speaking of ORW’s effective and proven tactics. The Hope(less) abortion clinic in fact did shut down for a full day, sparing 30-45 children due to a lack of an abortion nurse to assist in killing children. “ORW’s reputation of praying for abortion clinic workers in their home neighborhoods apparently convinced this abortion nurse to stay home and contemplate her dirty deeds,” said ORW’s President Troy Newman.

The three-day project in Illinois and

Missouri is part of a national plan to impart a vision to close down abortion mills. Through Newman’s dynamic leadership of Operation Rescue there have been numerous closures across the west. Says Newman, “There is no reason why the abortion mill in your home town can’t shut down as well.”

“The proven tactics are peaceful and non-violent,” Newman continued, “But they are aggressive direct action techniques that will expose the soft underbelly of the abortion trade.”

The Vision for Victory rallies were hosted by Daniel and Angela Michael of Small Victories with veteran pro-lifer leader Rev. Ed Martin co-sponsoring the weekend’s activities. The rallies featured guest speakers, Rev. Clenard Childress of LEARN, and Gregg Cunningham of CBR.

patience have paid off. Please join ORW in praying that the Oceanside Planned Parenthood will find no one who will rent office space to them and that their closure will be permanent.

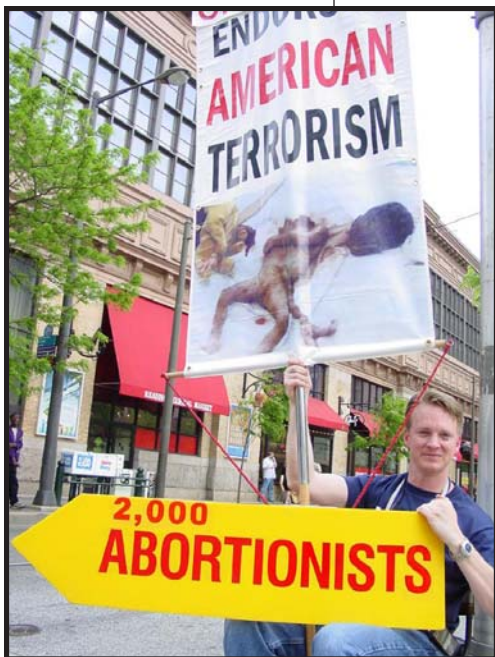

ORW reaches thousands of abortionists at the 2004 American College of Ob/Gyn's



Philadelphia, PA – Thousands of physicians under one roof – two thousand of them abortionists – was a perfect venue for the Truth Truck and hard-hitting preaching. The scene was the 52nd Annual Convention of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists in Philadelphia, and Operation Rescue West came prepared to challenge the abortion profiteers and collaborators.

Before the Ob/Gyns could enter the meeting where new techniques to kill children were being taught, the doctors and abortionists had to cross a picket line of pro-life activists. Bullhorns, Truth Trucks, Scripture reading, and huge signs greeted every patron of the downtown convention center. The reactions ran the

gamut. Many physicians stopped to debate, some angrily shouted foul language, and still others thanked the pro-life contingent that bravely withstood beating rain, sweltering heat, and 12-hour long days.

“This was the second ACOG convention we have attended and it won’t be the last. Next year ACOG is meeting in San Francisco, and if ACOG remains pro-abortion I can guarantee the same reception for every ACOG doctor and abortionist,” said Troy Newman, President Operation Rescue West.

Abortion Collaborators Exposed!

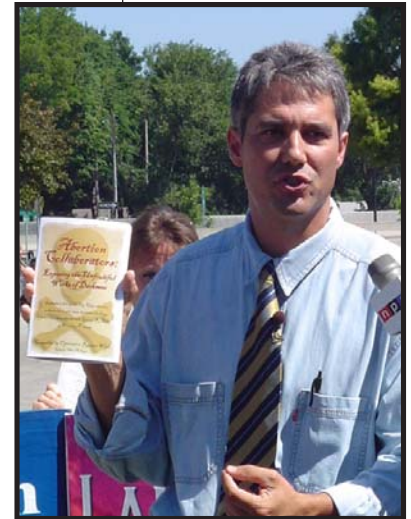
Wichita, KS — Operation Rescue West unveiled the Top Fifty Abortion Collaborators, businesses that have dealings with late-term abortionist George Tiller and his abortion mill, Women's Health Care Services of Wichita, Kansas, at a press conference on July 13, 2004. The entire list can be viewed at www.operationrescue.org. The Abortion Collaborator Campaign is a part of ORW's "Year of the Rebuke."

The day after the list of Abortion Collaborators was released, one of the vendors on the list announced that he would no longer accept Tiller's blood money.

The list was assembled because without the support of Wichita's business community, Tiller would not be able to continue to destroy innocent human lives. Recent polls conducted by ORW reveal that nearly 70% of Wichitans consider themselves pro-life and oppose late term

abortions. Just as public pressure has been used to keep other unseemly businesses out of Wichita, ORW is bringing public pressure to bear on area businesses that in any way trade with or support Tiller and his child-killing enterprise, encouraging them to terminate their abortion profiteering.

"ORW is making a solemn promise to expose the deadly connection between Wichita business owners and the most notorious baby butcher in the Western Hemisphere, George Tiller," said Cheryl Sullenger, ORW's Outreach Coordinator who researched and compiled the list. "These businesses can expect public pressure to be applied to them in a variety of legal and peaceful ways over the next few months, to shame them for their participation in the murder of innocent children."

Botched Abortion

Wichita, KS – ORW staffers snapped pictures and ran videotape as an ambulance arrived at Women's Health Care Services, the infamous late-term abortion mill owned by **George Tiller**, and transported a young blonde woman to Wesley Medical Center after being injured at the abortion clinic on June 4, 2004.

The woman was accompanied in the ambulance by Tiller, who personally escorted the woman into the Emergency Room. Also accompanying the ambulance was long-time Tiller employee Edna M. Roach.

According to witnesses, Roach attempted to hide her identity from those attempting to document the incident as she recklessly sped to the hospital ahead of the ambulance in Tiller's personal van.

Hospital security stood guard as the woman, with head covered, was wheeled into the Emergency Room with Tiller at her side. ORW staff members on the sidewalk outside the Emergency Room documenting the incident called out and urged the woman to sue Tiller for her injuries.

An anonymous source inside Wesley Medical Center told ORW that the woman indeed suffered from a botched abortion, but her stay at Wesley was cut short because there was not medical insurance and Tiller refused to pick up the tab.

"How many women have to be maimed and how many babies have to die before our community will run Tiller and his seedy chop shop out of town?" said Cheryl Sullenger, ORW missionary and eye-witness to the incident. If Wesley Medical Center would stop helping Tiller, he would not be able to continue to hurt women and kill babies. So in a very real way, Wesley shares in the murderer's guilt."

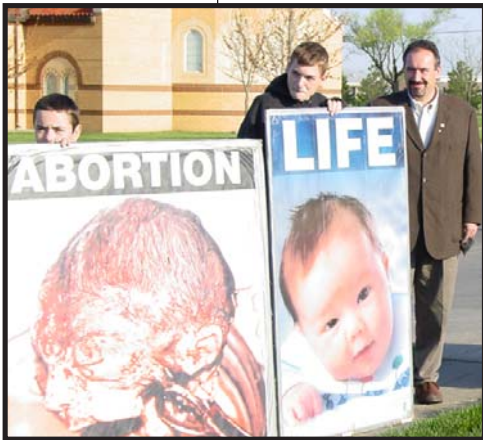
Be encouraged! We are winning this fight, and if we keep our hands to the plow, focusing our actions on achieving our goal, it is only a matter of time before our vision is realized.
