OFFICER'S OBSERVATIONS:

On July 4, 2016 at approx. 0040 hours I was dispatched to [REDACTED] for assist to medical. Dispatch advised a 24-year-old female was found unresponsive and not breathing. When I arrived I was directed to go to the backdoor. LifeCare medics and BCFD were arriving just before me.

I walked in the backdoor and contacted TANYA [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was very emotional and crying, stating she found her daughter unresponsive in the bedroom downstairs in the basement. After approx. 15 seconds, LifeCare medics started walking back up the stairs followed by BCFD personnel. One of the medics stated that the 24-year-old was deceased.

I did walk downstairs to [REDACTED] and into the basement. There is a side room off the basement that was turned into a bedroom. [REDACTED] stated that this bedroom is hers. In the middle of the bedroom is a bed which a female, ID as ERWIN-SHEPPARD, CREE BRIANNE, was lying across. ERWIN-SHEPPARD was not lying with the normal flow of the bed, from head-to-toe, as she was lying across it. Nothing was in disarray in the bedroom or throughout the basement.

LOCATION/DESCRIPTION OF BODY:

ERWIN-SHEPPARD was lying crossways across the bed wearing a tank top and pajama pants. There were no signs of trauma to the body.

INTERVIEW OF WITNESS TANYA HALL:

I again contacted [REDACTED], who stated she is the mother to ERWIN-SHEPPARD. HALL said on Thursday June 30 ERWIN-SHEPPARD had an abortion. HALL did not know what medical facility ERWIN-SHEPPARD had the abortion at. Since having that procedure, ERWIN-SHEPPARD had been complaining of severe abdominal pain.

On the night of July 2, 2016 HALL took ERWIN-SHEPPARD to BBC Hospital for treatment for abdominal pain. ERWIN-SHEPPARD got medical treatment and was discharged from the hospital. ERWIN-SHEPPARD's discharge paperwork was located in her purse showing she was discharged on July 3, 2016 at 0035 hours. [REDACTED] estimated that they did arrive home from the hospital at that approx. date and time.

[REDACTED] said ERWIN-SHEPPARD does not live with her, but because she was in so much pain she did not want to go home and wanted to stay at HALL's house. [REDACTED] allowed ERWIN-SHEPPARD to stay in her bed and [REDACTED] slept there with her. ERWIN-SHEPPARD was in so much pain that she climbed into bed crossways and did not want to move any further. [REDACTED] stated at approx. 5 a.m. she was getting very uncomfortable with the way ERWIN-SHEPPARD was sleeping across the foot of her bed and requested that she move up into the normal position.

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ERWIN-SHEPPARD did move slightly into the normal sleeping spot in the bed. [REDACTED] stated it was just enough for her to get comfortable again. When [REDACTED] woke up in the morning she thought ERWIN-SHEPPARD was just sleeping in. A couple times throughout the day [REDACTED] went down to check on ERWIN-SHEPPARD and she was still asleep.

[REDACTED] stated in the afternoon hours of July 3 she went down to check on ERWIN-SHEPPARD. At this time, ERWIN-SHEPPARD was breathing and her breathing seemed labored. [REDACTED] stated that she has a C-PAP machine for sleep apnea and her thoughts were that ERWIN-SHEPPARD was breathing like a person that had sleep apnea. When [REDACTED] described the sounds of ERWIN-SHEPPARD's breathing, to me, I believed the sounds she was making to have been agonal breathing.

On July 4, 2016 at approx. 0040 hours [REDACTED] went down to check on ERWIN-SHEPPARD again. It was at this time [REDACTED] tried to wake ERWIN-SHEPPARD. [REDACTED] stated ERWIN-SHEPPARD was cold to the touch and would not respond. After shaking and yelling at her she found that ERWIN-SHEPPARD was not breathing so she called 911.

[REDACTED] stated no one else was in or out of the house other than her husband [REDACTED] and her son [REDACTED] ERWIN. Both of them also live at 68 Latta.

Inside [REDACTED]'s bedroom were several different bottles of prescription medications. These bottles were prescribed to either TANYA [REDACTED] or [REDACTED]. There was one bottle prescribed to TANYA [REDACTED] that was empty. This bottle did appear to be in a different spot than the rest of TANYA [REDACTED]'s medications and next to [REDACTED]'s. This was a bottle of hydroxychloroquine. The bottle was filled on December 9, 2014 with 60 200mg pills.

TANYA [REDACTED] stated that she recalls being prescribed this as she still currently takes this medication. [REDACTED] stated that it would be out of the ordinary for her to not take all of the pills from the bottle, as again she is prescribed this and has to take it on a daily basis. [REDACTED] stated it is possible that the bottle never got thrown away and was just still in the room.

M.E. AND CASE NUMBER:

I original was contacted on the phone by M.E. JOANNE CATANIA. CATANIA originally stated she was having trouble getting ahold of an M.E. to respond to scene and she provide me with an M.E. case number over the phone. That number is 0704-16-JC-207-CC.

I was then advised that ROBIN QUICK would be responding to the scene and she did.
