## **Narrative**

L1 dispatched to abortion clinic for bleeding. P-100 masks, and standard precautions were worn.

Assessment reveals 26 year old female supine on the bed A/Ox4/4 complaining of feeling lightheaded and cramping. The doctor on scene states that the pt had a successful abortion at 22 weeks but has been bleeding for over an hour. They state that there is a catheter in place in her uterus to help control bleeding but it has not been able to stop the bleeding. They had a 22 gauge IV emplaced prior to our arrival. Pt was moved to the stretcher and secured with rails and straps.

Vital signs taken. Pt was hypotensive.

Pt was moved to L1 and secured. IV was started 20 gauge left ac with normal saline bolus administered. Pt was transported priority 2 to Providence Southfield ER. Radio report called to hospital. Pt's vital signs and condition were monitored throughout transport and her blood pressure rose after fluid administration. Pt care report and care transferred to nurse. DD FF/PM
